## CONTROL MEASURES FOR SAFE USE:

### Control Measures

Avoid direct contact with the substance. Ensure there is sufficient ventilation of the area. Do not handle in a confined space. Avoid the formation or spread of mists in the air. Smoking is forbidden. Use non-sparking tools.

### Storage

Store in cool, well-ventilated area. Keep container tightly closed. Keep away from sources of ignition. Prevent the build-up of electrostatic charge in the immediate area. Ensure lighting and electrical equipment are not a source of ignition.

Skin contact: There may be irritation and redness at the site of contact. Eye contact: There may be irritation and redness. The eyes may water profusely. Swallowed	Wash out mouth with water. Do not induce vomiting. If conscious, give half a litre of water to drink immediately. Consult a doctor.	In Contact with Skin	Remove all contaminated clothes and footwear immediately unless stuck to skin. Drench the affected skin with running water for 10 minutes or longer if substance is still on skin. Consult a doctor.
Inhaled	: Remove casualty from exposure ensuring one's own safety whilst doing so. Consult a doctor.	In Contact with Eyes	: Bathe the eye with running water for 15 minutes. Consult a doctor.

## ACCIDENTAL RELEASE MEASURES:

Mark out the contaminated area with signs and prevent access to unauthorised personnel. Turn leaking containers leak-side up to prevent the escape of liquid. Eliminate all sources of ignition.
